Tuition, Fees & Financial Aid

Tuition:

\$396 per credit hour (including required one-hour orientation)

Fees:

- Application Fee (non-refundable, submit with application): \$50
- Student General Fee: \$20 per credit hour
- Technology Fee: \$25 per credit hour
- Graduation Fee: \$100
- Audit Fee: \$250

Financial Aid:

Graduate students must submit a FAFSA every academic year to apply for financial aid. The FAFSA can be completed online at www.fafsa.ed.gov and becomes available on Jan. 1. Stephens' FAFSA Code is 002512. Financial Aid eligibility will be determined based on the information submitted on the FAFSA and enrollment, and is dependent upon admission to a graduate program. By completing the FAFSA, graduate students may be eligible to receive a Federal Stafford unsubsidized loan each academic year.

Stephens offers the following tuition discounts for the M.S.L. program:

- Ideal Grant (for Stephens alumnae): Tuition reduction of \$75 per credit hour
- Community Connections Grant (for those who live or work in Boone or Cole counties): Tuition reduction of \$50 per credit hour
- Parent Grant (for parents of current Stephens residential undergraduate students): 30% tuition reduction

*No grants can be combined.

Other items to include in a 12-month budget and should be taken into account for cost of attendance might include the following (based on an estimated annual average cost): books and supplies (\$1,800); room and board (\$11,264); transportation (\$2,180) and miscellaneous living expenses (\$2,895).
