Additional Information for Health Science at Stephens College:

The Bachelor of Science in Health Science major requires completion of general education requirements and of required courses, plus major electives in the areas of business, education, life sciences (BIO, CHM, HIA, PHY), and psychology. A grade of C or better must be earned in required life science courses (BIO, CHM, PHY) to graduate. All pre-professional studies (pre-med, pre-vet, pre-dental, etc.) are strongly advised to complete the chemistry sequence through organic chemistry (CHM 342), plus BIO 182 and PHY 211/212, even though they are not requirements of the major. Students should select a math course that is consistent with their career goals. In addition to the departmental requirements listed above, students must also complete coursework for Stephens College residency and B.A./B.S./B.F.A. degree requirements of a total 120* college level semester hours and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Students should meet with an IVCC or Stephens College academic adviser to develop a transfer plan that will prepare them for meeting their individual career goals. *All baccalaureate degrees require completion of at least 36 semester hours of advanced-level courses (300 level or above).
