Good Afternoon Stephens Community,

In preparation of the Active Assailant training scheduled on this coming Wednesday February 28, the Columbia Streets Department will be posting "No Street Parking" signs along Melbourne and Ripley streets starting on Tuesday February 27. Any vehicle parked on Ripley between Walnut and College and on Melbourne between Windsor and Walnut after the streets are posted will be towed by the city. To assist with parking needs on Tuesday February 27th and Wednesday February 28th the Safety and Security Department will allow non permitted student/staff vehicles to park in the Hillcrest parking lot.

On Wednesday the following campus parking lots will be closed at 5:00 pm. (1) Library, (2) LRW, and (3) the Ripley Street staff/visitor. If you park in one of these three lots please have your vehicle removed from the lot by 5:00 pm. Once emergency vehicle begin to arrive on campus and surrounding streets closed for the training exercise, it will become very difficult if not impossible to retrieve your vehicle from the lots.

Also at 5:00 pm the entire Learning Center complex will be closed to everyone (Walter Hall, Dudley Hall, Columbia Foyer, Windsor Auditorium, Helis Communication Center, Pillsbury Science Center). For those students who have classes on Wednesday evening your class has been relocated. Please contact your instructor for the new location. Parking will be available in the campus lots south of Broadway regardless on how the lots are posted. I also recommend parking in the city parking garage located next to Sampson Hall. City garage parking is free after 6:00 pm.

The training exercise will be completed no later than 11:00 pm and the Learning Center complex will be reopened for use.
