



FINANCIAL AID: COST OF ATTENDANCE

Tuition:

\$361 per credit hour
(including required one-hour orientation)

Financial Aid:

HIA students must submit a FAFSA every academic year to apply for financial aid. The FAFSA can be completed online at www.fafsa.ed.gov and becomes available on Oct. 1. Stephens' FAFSA Code is 002512. Financial Aid eligibility will be determined based on the information submitted on the FAFSA and enrollment, and is dependent upon admission to the HIA program. By completing the FAFSA, students may be eligible to receive Federal and State aid.

Fees:

(non-refundable, submit with application): \$50
- Student General Fee: \$20 per credit hour
- Technology Fee: \$25 per credit hour
- Graduation Fee: \$100
- Proctored Exam Fees: \$22.50 per exam
- Neehr Perfect subscriptions: \$45 for 12 weeks/
\$105 for 40 week academic year (required for some classes)
- RHIA exam (optional): \$229

2017-2018 Cost of Attendance

The cost of attendance (COA) refers to the total amount of education expenses (tuition, books and supplies, room and board, personal expenses, transportation expenses, loan fees, etc.). Stephens College bills for direct costs, the items highlighted in blue, at the beginning of each semester. Other indirect costs are estimates. A student may borrow up to the COA during each semester.
