



## FINANCIAL AID: COST OF ATTENDANCE

### MASTER OF EDUCATION IN COUNSELING

#### Tuition:

\$404 per credit hour  
(including required one-hour orientation)

#### Fees:

- Counseling Practicum Fee/Semester: \$200
- Application Fee (non-refundable, submit with application): \$50
  - Student General Fee: \$20 per credit hour
  - Technology Fee: \$25 per credit hour
  - Graduation Fee: \$100
  - Audit Fee: \$250

#### Financial Aid:

Graduate students must submit a FAFSA every academic year to apply for financial aid. The FAFSA can be completed online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) and becomes available on Oct. 1. Stephens' FAFSA Code is 002512. Financial Aid eligibility will be determined based on the information submitted on the FAFSA and enrollment, and is dependent upon admission to a graduate program. By completing the FAFSA, graduate students may be eligible to receive a Federal Stafford unsubsidized loan each academic year.

### 2017-2018 Cost of Attendance

The cost of attendance (COA) refers to the total amount of education expenses (tuition, books and supplies, room and board, personal expenses, transportation expenses, loan fees, etc.). Stephens College bills for direct costs, the items highlighted in blue, at the beginning of each semester. Other indirect costs are estimates. A student may borrow up to the COA during each semester.
