Boone Hospital Center's Patient Care Technician (PCT) Trainee Program is perfect for pre-nursing students. A PCT performs various direct patient care functions and works closely with a nurse to ensure our patients receive the highest level of personal care. In this program, you'll receive both classroom and hands-on instruction in direct patient care to prepare you to be a PCT.

Our PCT Trainee Program offers a pre-nursing opportunity for students with the interest and ambition to work in a real patient care setting. You'll get direct patient care experience that can benefit you as you complete your nursing degree – plus the rewarding opportunity to make a difference for our patients!

How It Works

Our PCT Trainee Program includes a five-week paid training period from **July 5 through August 14** at Boone Hospital Center. Attendance is mandatory at these training sessions.

After you successfully complete the training, you'll transition to a Boone Hospital Flex PCT. We offer virtual self-scheduled shifts of

4, 8 and 12 hours, with a minimum of 16 hours in off shifts per month, which include Saturdays, Sundays and weekdays between 3 p.m. and 7 a.m.
