His training includes Brown University (M.F.A, Stephen Sondheim Fellow), Roosevelt University (B.F.A, Newberry Library Fellow), LAMDA, and Harvard University. Alongside his work with Stephens, Jamey also serves as Core Faculty and Head of Acting for the Perry-Mansfield Performing Arts School in Colorado.

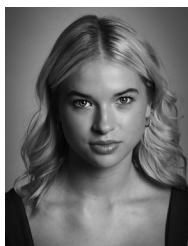
Duncan Elder

RiQuandrión Mangum

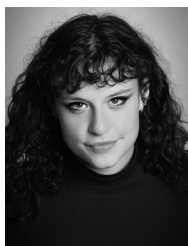

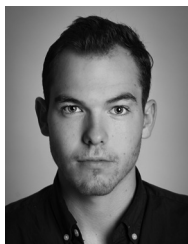
Emmalee Eve Bass

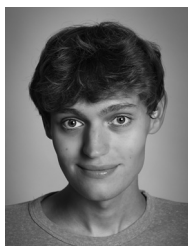
Alley Mathis
